In order to ensure that every student can successfully complete their courses and achieve excellent results, GEA has specially designed after-school tutoring courses to help students with their academic challenges.



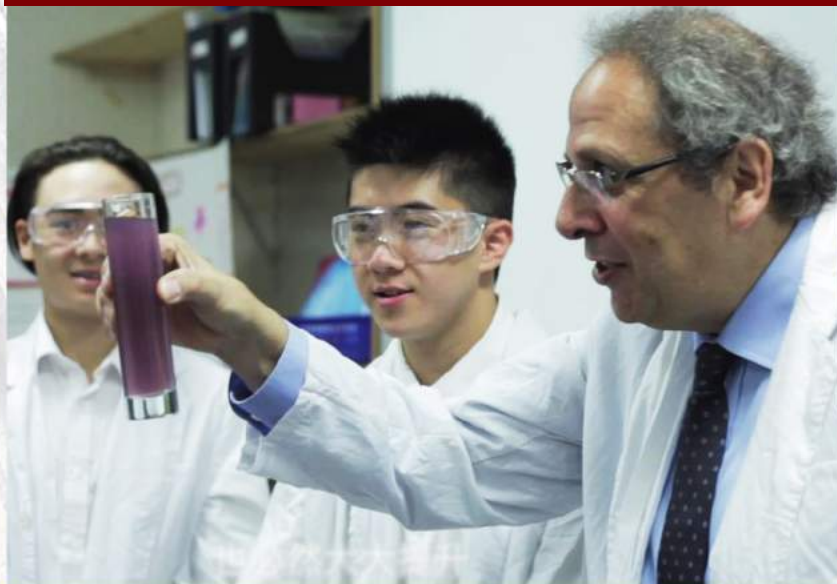

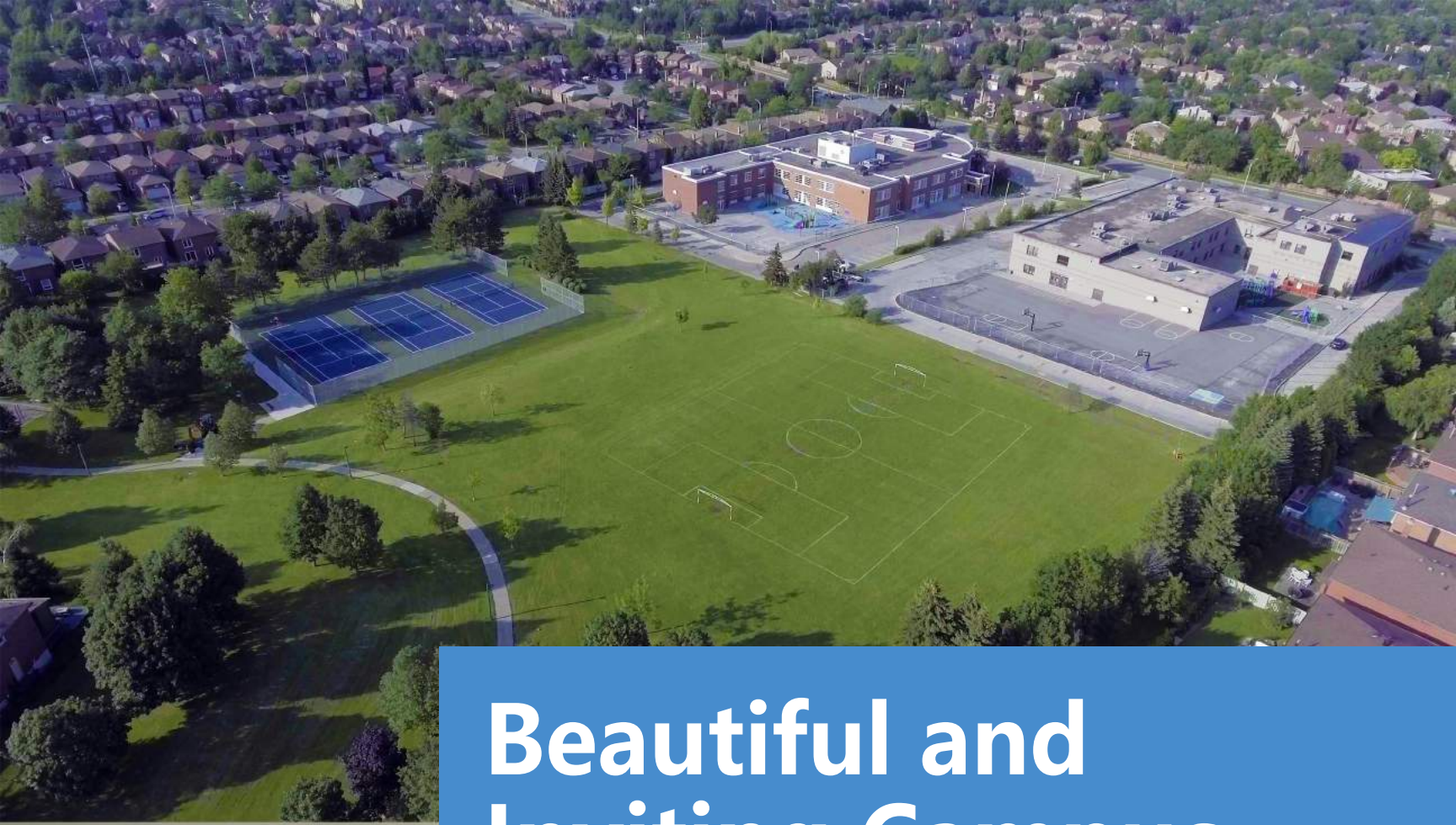
Scholarship Nomination Priority

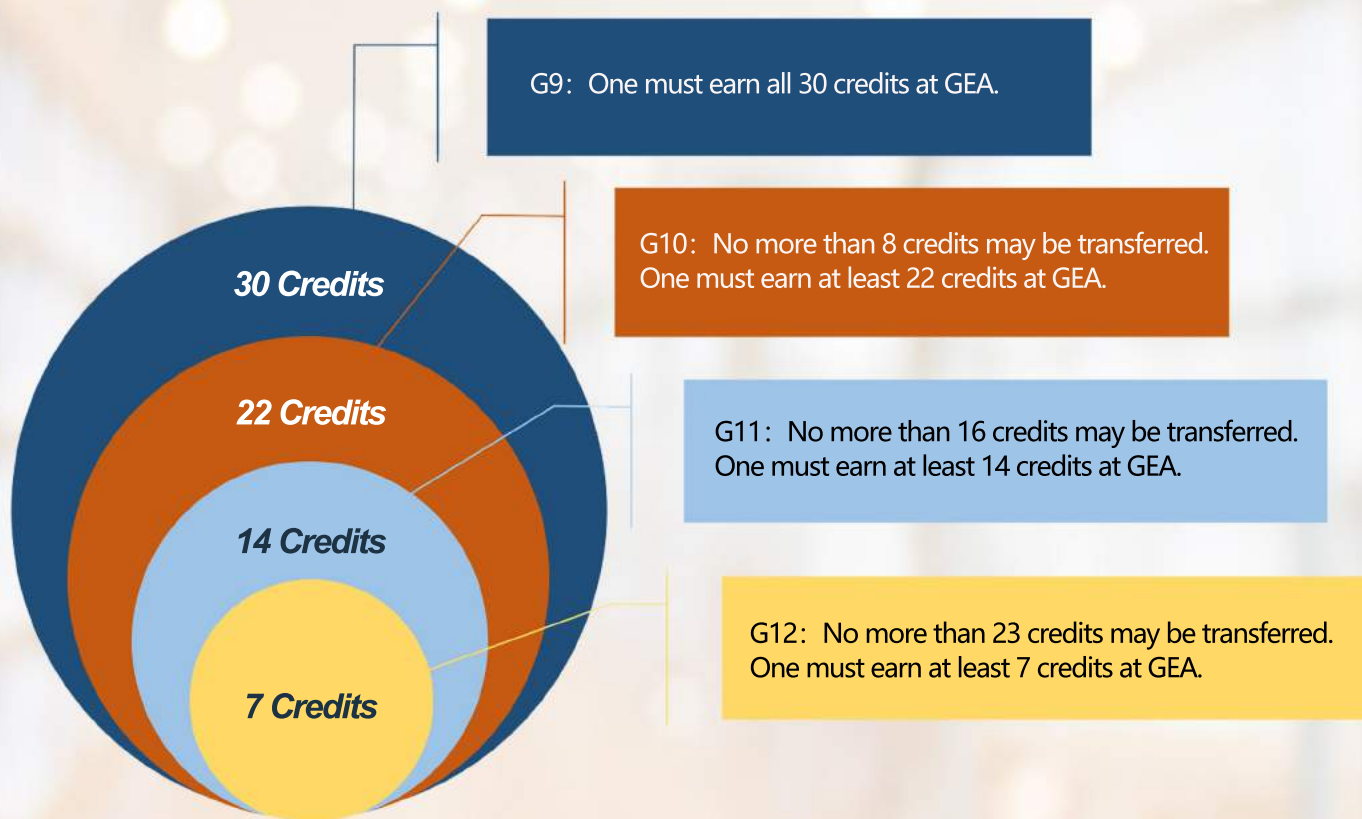


Ontario Secondary School Diploma

For international students who have finished all secondary courses in their home countries.

Program Overview

International students who have finished all secondary courses in their home countries will only need to earn 6 credits at GEA to be awarded the Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

University Application Guidance

We offer UPP students 1-on-1 university application guidance. Our services include OUAC (Ontario Universities' Application Centre) application assistance, application materials preparation and supporting documents submission.

Why UPP?

When applying to an Ontario university, UPP graduates are eligible to submit OUAC 101 applications as current Ontario high school students. This usually means faster decisions and higher admission rates.

Come Anytime

There are multiple start dates available for UPP students every year. However, students who have not met university language proficiency requirements are strongly recommended to register for the earliest start date possible to be admitted into the next available ESL or IELTS courses.
