Associate of Arts Degree

General Requirements:

1) Complete minimum of 60 University Transfer (UT) credits that transfer to one of the British Columbian Research Universities (SFU, UBC, UNBC, or UVIC)

2) Achieve an average grade of "C" or 2.0 GPA ("P" grade in a course is accepted if minimum cumulative overall GPA of 2.0 is met)

3) Check course transferability using the BC Transfer Guide at: <u>www.bctransferguide.ca</u> (Research Universities)

4) Coquitlam College will not transfer an English grade below C-

6) ENGL 103 may receive credits for 2nd year ARTS if 6 credits of English have already been successfully completed.

7) POL 101& 103 may receive credits for 1st OR 2nd year ARTS.

8) EDUC 101 can only be use as general electives.

Note:

-Transferability of courses is determined by the receiving institution

- Students interested in the Post Graduate Work Permit (PGWP) must be full-time students throughout their degree.

- Each course can only be counted once towards the completion of the program

- Students may apply to transfer a maximum of 10 university courses (30 credits)

Definitions:

1st Year Course: Any course that transfers as assigned or unassigned credit to at least one Research University

<u>**2**</u>nd <u>**Year Course:**</u> Any course that transfers as assigned or unassigned credit at the 200-level or higher to at least one Research University.

<u>Arts Courses</u>: Any course in a subject area for which there is a Baccalaureate of Arts degree at: SFU, UBC, UNBC, or UVIC (Except Business, Computer Science, Math, or traditional Sciences)

Elective Courses: Any course that has transferability to one of the 4 BC research universities. (SFU, UNBC, UVIC, UBC)
